Students: Kenter kids are encouraged to use their skills learned in Kenter art classes to create a 8.5" X 11" poster that "inspires" safe driving. Posters are due February 26 in the Parent Center. One poster from each grade will receive a special award at an upcoming assembly. Selected student leaders will help create a PSA announcement for Kenter website and to share with all parents.

Parents: Ensure use of seat belts/booster seats; adhere to parking rules; honor disabled parking spaces; respect neighbors' driveways and red zone/curbs; do not leave vehicles unattended in front loop; avoid turnabout / improper U-turns; use Kenter's valet safety program---but remember to pull as far forward as possible.

Staff: Serve as role model drivers; encourage participation; attend safety meetings; remind students to use crosswalk, walk bikes on campus; be alert.

Community: You'll recognize K.I.D.S. signs on sidewalks and lawns encouraging role model driver safety.
