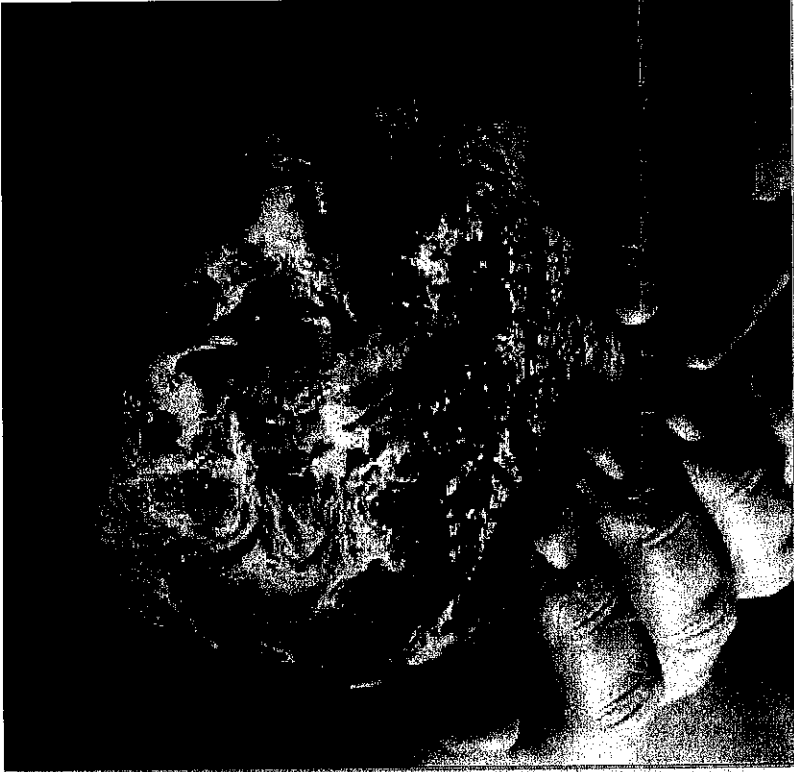


Earth Day Poster Challenge

I would like to invite you and your students to participate in my 5th Annual Earth Day Poster Challenge in honor of Earth Day 2018 on April 25th. This challenge is a great way to get students of all ages involved in a creative, environmentally friendly contest to promote this year's Earth Day theme, "Environmental and Climate Literacy."

To participate, students must submit a poster related to the 2018 theme of "Environmental and Climate Literacy." The poster should be 8 ½" by 11" and must be on recycled paper. The poster can use any form of media including, but not limited to, photos, drawings, paintings and collages. Some examples may include such things as showing an understanding of environmental advocacy, importance of renewable energy, or anything that shows basic understanding of the importance for caring for our planet.

All posters must be submitted to my District Office Attn: Melissa Kaufler at 2800 28th Street, Suite 105, Santa Monica, CA, 90405 no later than **Friday, April 27, 2018**. Posters received after that date will not be considered in this year's contest. All posters must have school information, teacher information, full name, grade level and signed release form (attached) to be considered. Winners will be announced the following week.

There will be three (3) First Prize Winners, each selected from the K-3rd, 4th-6th and 7th-12th grade categories. There will also be one (1) Grand Prize Winner selected from the entire participant pool. All winners will receive a personalized letter from me, a California State Assembly Certificate of Recognition, have their posters put on display in my office and on my social media accounts. In addition, Blick Art Supply has graciously agreed to provide four gift certificates to each of the winning student's classrooms to be used by the instructor to purchase art supplies for the classroom.
