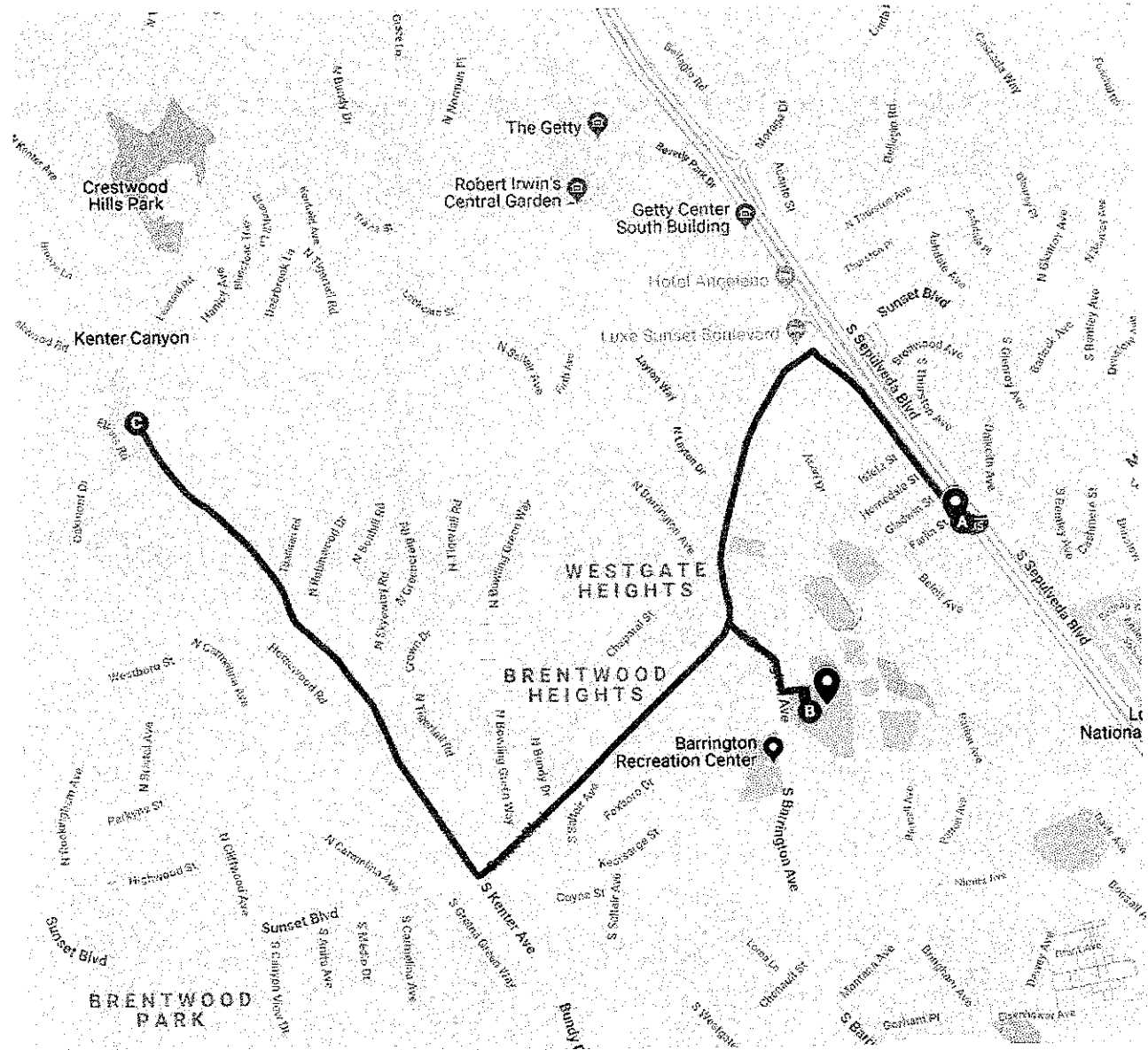

FAQ's

- (1) Who is providing the bus service?
This is not a service of Kenter Canyon Elementary School. The bus is being provided by Tumbleweed Transportation under contract with the Brentwood School.
- (2) Will there be seatbelts on the bus?
Yes.
- (3) Why am I writing a check to the Brentwood School?
The Brentwood School is helping to get the program off the ground by paying upfront for the bus and contracting directly with Tumbleweed Transportation. There is no profit or fee to the Brentwood School for their services.
- (4) What will happen in the event that fewer than 20 riders sign up for the bus?
In the event that there have been fewer than 20 paid registrations by the registration deadline, the administrators will make a decision to either (a) extend the registration deadline, or (b) terminate the program. In the event that the program is terminated, all registration fees paid will be refunded in full.
- (5) How am I benefitting from the subsidy that has been procured?
The cost per rider for a 20 person bus exceeds \$1000 for the prorated year; the subsidy brings the cost down to \$650 per rider.
