

## Extra Practice in Language Arts and Math

*\*Even though these are computer based tests, students will be able to use scratch paper, so please encourage them to show their work on all math problems.*

- a. Click on "Practice & Training Tests" (green oval, third from the left)
- b. Select "Student Interface Practice and Training Tests" (Green picture on the right)
- c. Click "Sign in" (Green button at the bottom of the page)
- d. Select the desired grade level and click "Yes"
- e. Choose any of the pink colored testing options at the top of the page.
- f. Choose Settings: click "Select".
- g. Sound and Video Playback Check: press the "play" button and follow the prompt. Click "I could play the video and sound"; THEN click "Continue"
- h. Instructions and Help: Select "Begin Test Now"

### **How to check your child's work:**

*\*Note:* unfortunately, your child is not able to save the practice test, so each question must be corrected while the student is on that page OR once your child finishes the test, just use the back button or question scroll on the top left side of the screen.

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- a. Click on "Practice & Training Tests"
- b. Select "Test Administrator and Test Examiner Resources for Practice and Training Tests" (Brown picture in the middle)
- c. Scroll down under the grid, until you reach "Smarter Balanced Scoring Rubrics" and the appropriate grade level.
- d. Choose the test(s) that your child is taking – you will find both the questions, answers, and rationales for varying scores.
