

# Kenter Canyon Elementary Charter School

## **TALENT SHOW GUIDELINES & AGREEMENT**

*The Talent Show is a joint LAUSD-PSG sponsored event. For liability, safety and ethical reasons, the following guidelines are established to insure a productive, enjoyable evening for all performance and audience guests.*

- Students may perform in ONE act only, as an individual or with a group.
- Parents are responsible for registering the students within an act using the sign-in link on our school's website. Once the performers have auditioned, there can be NO changes in performers without Principal authorization. Example: If three students audition to perform a dance, it is expected that those three students will be the only students to perform in the Talent Show for that act. Acts may not add on or substitute students after the auditions end.
- Students MUST attend the rehearsals and performances as indicated on the schedule.
- Any student who is absent or leaves school early on performance days will not be allowed to perform in either Talent Show performance. Kenter Canyon's instructional program must remain our priority for the duration of all school days.
- Students involved in disciplinary matters may lose the privilege of attending the shows or performing their act. This decision is at the Principal's discretion.
- Students with excessive absences may not be approved to perform in this extra-curricular activity. A decision will be made between the teacher and Principal.
- Performance attires needs to be appropriate for an elementary school and fit the act itself, such as a ballet dancer's outfit may have a strapped top or partially backless. For most acts, inappropriate performance attire may include items that expose any student's stomach, shoulders or back, such as short-shorts, tube tops, low-cut tops, spaghetti strap tops, tank tops, muscle shirts and high heels. If it doubt, ask the Talent Show Co-Chairs or the Principal.
- Lyrics, scripts and music must be appropriate for elementary school. Inappropriate content includes any reference to adult topics or behaviors, mocking others, belittling individuals or groups because of one's ethnicity, gender, size, religion, sexual orientation or age.
- Performers are expected to remain in holding rooms throughout the performance times. Parents may see their children during intermission. Students who attend the performance MUST have a ticket to join their parents. There is no lap-seating in our auditorium. The school has the responsibility to protect the performers during the Talent Show. When parents encourage their children to come and go, it creates a liable situation for our employees hired to supervise the holding rooms.
- Students will be permitted to go to the concession after their act has been performed if they are given money for that purpose. Lite snacks and water will also be in the holding rooms.
- The dress rehearsal for Kenter Canyon student body will be canceled if 3-4 parent volunteers are not available in each holding room during the morning and afternoon rehearsal times.
- Students may not use the auditorium or any school facilities to rehearse their act without prior Principal approval. Violations could result in the act being eliminated from the program. At least one parent for every 3 children must be in attendance to supervise any on campus rehearsals that were authorized by the Principal.
